- Jogo Bonito The Champions Cup Soccer Tournament.



Competitive Soccer Program

Competitive soccer offers youth players the opportunity to enhance their individual and team skills under the guidance of licensed and experienced coaches. Specially trained coaching staff introduce new techniques and tactics over the course of the 10-month travel soccer season. Competitive soccer teams compete in tournaments and leagues throughout South Florida participating in the South Florida Youth Soccer League, Weston Cup, West Pines Kickoff Classic, Naples Cup, and more.

The goal of the competitive soccer program is to promote the individual personal growth of each player providing positive role models to emulate and producing the next generation of professional players through exposure in international youth tournaments and competitions. Brazilian Soccer Training Center is comprised of 13 competitive teams. In 2019, the U10 Boys team got second place at the Disney Memorial Day Soccer Shootout and placed third in the Citta di Censena Junior Soccer Cup in Censenatico, Italy.

Recreational Soccer

After School Program

The recreational program is the backbone of Brazilian Soccer Training Center where kids ages four and up are introduced to the "beautiful game" of soccer. The primary objective in the recreational program is for players to have fun, fall in love with the game, and grasp the fundamentals of playing soccer. Players are exposed to sportsmanship, team ethics, and intramural game participation.

The recreational program schedule is broken up quarterly, giving the players a chance to move to travel soccer as his/her abilities improve and their love for the game grows.




EVENTS
